## On the handset

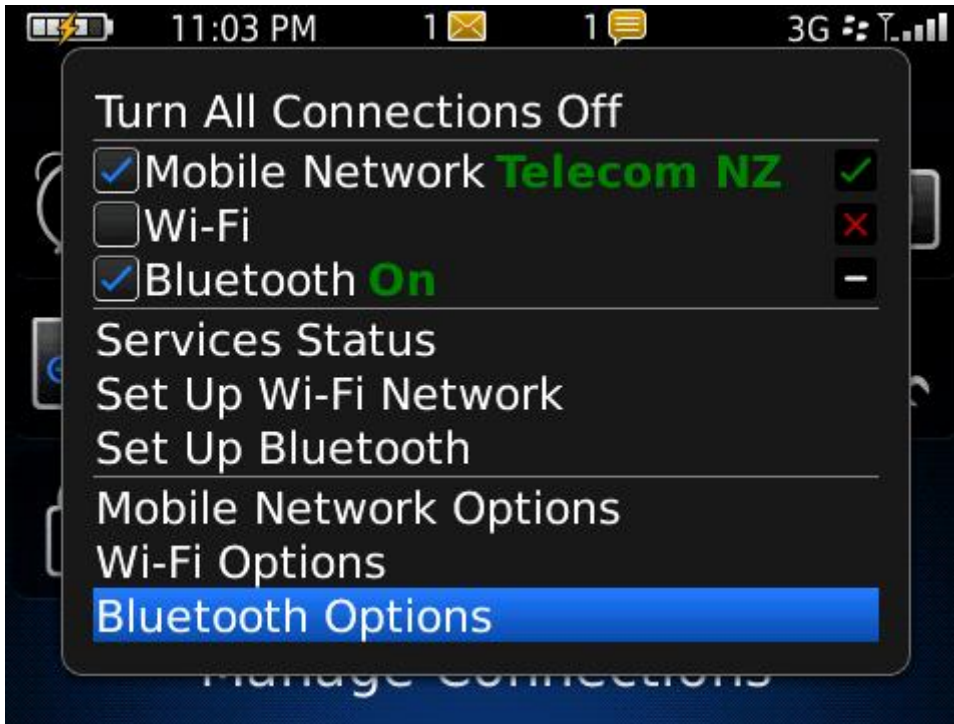
1. From the main screen, press the **Menu key**.
